Inland Chapter Local Dues

Since 1996, the Inland Chapter of USA dance has been requesting local membership dues from its chapter members. The \$15 that was charged covered newsletter mailings and funding of events.. In 2005 USA Dance - National raised membership dues by \$5 per member and sent that \$5 per member to each chapter. The Inland Chapter at that time lowered the local dues to \$10 per member. The Board of USA Dance-Inland Chapter has voted at this point to no longer charge local dues. However, a yearly \$10 per household subscription fee to those addresses receiving the paper version of the newsletter will be charged and may be adjusted as postage increases. New members will, however, receive a "first year free" subscription to the mailed chapter newsletter with a subscription renewal form in December for the following years.

The newsletter will be distributed via the chapter website with an email announcement to all members that supply an email address. If we do not have your email address, please submit it to us if you do not want the paper newsletter and you will not be charged for a subscription. Only dues to the national USA dance organization will be necessary to remain as a member in good standing and to receive the benefits of membership which include discounted admission to certain events (membership card must be presented).
